CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter presents conclusion, as well as some suggestions for future research.

A. Conclusion

As stated in the first chapter, the goal of this research is to identify the types of representative speech act and how the speaker convey the representative speech act in Wrath of Jodi youtube videos. The researcher examined only utterances that included the representative speech act. Several conclusions can be drawn from the data analysis based on the problem formulation.

Based on the analysis of the utterances delivered by speaker's in "Wrath of Jodi", the findings showed that the utterances in the video "Wrath of Jodi" had all types of representative speech act proposed by John R. Searle, which were stating, reporting, concluding, suggesting, and complaining. The utterances in "Wrath of Jodi" presented more representative speech act of reporting directly than other acts.

Besides, there were found 41 data which were conveyed directly, and 9 data which were conveyed indirectly. The references for determining the representative speech acts conveyed directly or indirectly in Travis Alexander Murder Case are based on the meaning of the utterance, and the purpose of the utterance.

Thus, it can be concluded that among the five types of representative speech act, reporting directly is the dominant type used in the Wrath of Jodi video. This type is the most dominant, because the video made by JCS-Criminal Psychology is a video that comments or tells the audience what is happening on the screen and how the narrator responds to the situations or actions that appear on the screen.

B. Suggestions

In the last sub-chapter, the researcher wants to give suggestions for other writers who might be interested in this topic to expand the topic of their research, such as combining representative speech act with expressive speech act, and to expand the object of the research. It could be from a website that has a variety of videos like 9gag, Reddit, etc.
