This research focuses on the discussion about the Expression of Disappointment. This research is motivated by the high interest in literary works, especially popular ones in the form song lyrics. Song Lyrics itself is an expression of someone about something that has been seen, heard or experienced. In expressing his experience, the writer or the creator of the song plays a game of words and language to create attraction and uniqueness of the lyrics. Song lyrics as one of the building elements in a song or music can be categorized as poetry in literary works. There are two problems of the research. First, what types of figurative language expressed in the song lyrics of *Led Zeppelin*. Second, how is the disappointment expressed in the song lyrics of Led Zeppelin. In analyzing the data, the researcher classified the figurative language data based on Perrine's theory (1992).
